As the sole Developer on the Digital Marketing team I have been responsible for a complete overhaul of the Beaumont Legal (a subsidiary of Legal Zoom) website. This site was built on Laravel with Object Oriented PHP following a strict MVC model and includes a backend Quote system for customers as well as data being pulled from various Databases. On top of this I was also in charge of creating regular HTML emails, ensuring they are responsive and work across all browsers and email clients.

As part of a team of Designers and Copy Writers all working remotely, communication was key and as other Developers in the company may need to work on the site code from time to time it was vital that all code be kept tidy, well commented and regularly pushed to Git - something I pride myself on.

I registered my business, [Web Connexions](#) in 2013, however before this I had been freelancing as a website designer during my years at university alongside my studies. I quickly realised this was my passion and have not looked back since. I design bespoke websites for a variety of business using HTML, CSS, Javascript and PHP.
